



Call for Presentations for the 34th Annual Conference of the American Assembly for Men in Nursing October 23rd & 24th, 2009 in Cincinnati, Ohio

Conference Theme: Men: Making a Difference in Nursing

The American Assembly for Men in Nursing is currently accepting submissions for oral and poster presentations for its annual conference, hosted by the Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center. AAMN is seeking submissions from a variety of disciplines as well as nursing to present in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Submissions should address **one or more** of the following conference objectives:

1. Evaluate the impact of the male nurse on men's health issues and in direct care delivery.
2. Describe initiatives developed to advance men's health issues and concerns.
3. Recognize various roles in nursing, created by men, which impact a variety of health care delivery systems.
4. Compare and contrast strategies used to recruit men into nursing which remove barriers and facilitate male entry into the nursing profession.
5. Explore the role of the male-nurse mentor in practice to promote recruitment and retention of men in nursing.
6. Examine educational initiatives targeting the learning needs of male nurses.

Required Format

Research Abstract

1. Title
2. Problem or Research Question
3. Theoretical Framework
4. Methods/Design
5. Findings

Non-Research Abstract

1. Title
2. Contribution to the Literature
3. Key Concepts
4. Synopsis
5. Conclusion

The required length of the abstract is 250-500 words submitted on a one-page, single-spaced typed page, 8.5 x 11" paper with one-inch margin on all sides. Submissions must include a cover sheet with the title of the abstract, name(s) of author(s), address, and contact telephone number and e-mail address. Do not include bibliographies or articles with the submission. Please indicate your preference for an oral or poster presentation. ***All abstracts are subject to a blind review process and candidates will be notified by email of their acceptance or regrets of committee to present in Cincinnati.*** With acceptance each presenter will be required to complete paperwork for continuing education credits which will be forwarded to you. Presenters are required to register and pay conference fees.
